



Transition norms for year 3 4

From mh3, pupils can be promoted to mavo 4 or to havo 4. From hv3, pupils can be promoted to havo 4 or to (tt)vwo 4. The admission requirements to havo 4 from mh3 and hv3 are identical.

MYP scores, deficit points and compensation points

Assessment and reporting is based on four assessment criteria (0-8) in each subject. All assessment criteria are tested at least twice per school year. We call the sum of the results of the four assessment criteria the MYP SUM (which runs from 0-32). The limit values for good, sufficient, just not sufficient and insufficient are for mavo, havo and vwo:

Within the transition standards count:

- All chosen subjects in the profile and free section (with criterion requirement)
- All other subjects (without criterion requirement)

Core subjects scheme mavo

Only one deficit point may be obtained in Dutch.

Core subjects scheme havo/vwo

In the subjects Dutch, English and mathematics, a combined score of no more than one deficit point is allowed.

Three categories can be distinguished: promote, discuss, reject.

Promote

The student's file must be in order (no missing assessments unless there is a valid reason). N.B. The subject KCKV must be passed in mh3.

Students who have at most one deficit point can be promoted within the relevant education level without compensation.

From the roof tile mavo/havo 3 can be further promoted:

- to mavo 4 with two deficit points and one compensation point at mavo level
- to havo 4 with two deficit points and two compensation points at havo level

From the dakpan havo/vwo 3 can be further promoted:

- to havo 4 with two deficit points and two compensation points at havo level
- to vwo 4 with two deficit points and two compensation points at vwo level

Discuss

Any student who falls one point short of promotion and/or whose file is not in order will be discussed. The teachers' meeting decides. This decision may also require the pupil to participate in the Summer School (the final test thereof will then determine whether the pupil is still promoted) or complete another assignment.

Reject

Rejected is any student who falls short of promotion by at least two points.

The team leader and/or the report meeting do reserve the right to discuss a pupil in exceptional cases, even if it is not in accordance with the above-mentioned limits. No rights can be derived from these exceptions.
